Dispatch Technical Advisory Council (TAC) Meeting Minutes

June 21, 2010

Agenda:

- Status of the 700 MHz radio project - Radios are here but the final FCC licenses have not been approved. Once the approval has been received the radios will be programmed and put into use.
- Discussion of VHF vs. 700 - Law enforcement will be testing prior to Fire department switching over. VHF system more expensive. 700 system in place already, would need to add repeaters to fix holes. Carey fire, blue and yellow channels need to be upgraded. The Harrison site is up and providing coverage to the south county.
- Brad Vollmer from ClearCom discussed Digital UHF VHF and 700 systems and trunk system. He also discussed costs of programming and will research reprogramming costs.
- Red Flag Warnings - Procedure to be set in place to Single Alert Tone to Gold1/Yellow1/Red1 channels by 8 am. Research how this procedure can be implemented with the assistance of South Central Dispatch
- Lat/long data and cell phone pings protocol- Rebid on cell calls long/lat do rebid pinging, subscriber information. Information was not available for all carriers but has since been placed in a book with Exigent Circumstances Forms for each carrier.
- Policy for linked calls – which EMS calls do we need to automatically send LE and vice versa – get a list for policy. Discussion regarding Law Enforcement being dispatched to Fire and EMS calls on an as needed basis instead of simul-selected.
- CAD EMD function – Discussion of proposed software research for CAD/EMD systems. Currently ProQua and APCO Meds being reviewed. ProQA better system but more expensive

- New recording system – Researching new recording systems that are compatible with Next Generation 9-1-1. Current system not compatible.
- Specific CAD problems (users) – Perfect function of the CAD system, Rebuilt reporting systems; what add-ons are available and what can CAD do for respective agencies.
- CAD notifications – the city is not currently being included in the notifications from CAD - get Logisys to add those
