## Annual Certificate of Number Dollars

### Resident and Non-Resident fees

Of the \$32.50 -

- \$1.50 goes to vendor fees
- \$1.00 goes to the Snowmobile Search & Rescue Fund
- Up to 15% can be used for administrative fees incurred by IDPR
- No less than \$25.50 goes to County Snowmobile Grooming Programs

### Rental fees

Of the \$62.50 -

- \$1.50 Goes to vendor fees
- \$1.00 Goes to the Snowmobile Search & Rescue Fund
- Up to 15% can be used for administrative fees incurred by IDPR
- No less than \$51.00 goes to County Snowmobile Grooming Programs

### County Snowmobile Grooming Programs

The County Administered Snowmobile Grooming Programs are run by an advisory committee who are active snowmobilers and appointed by the county commissioners.

### Grooming - Maintenance - Plowing Parking Lots

The number of user designations to a county grooming program dictates the level of service that program can provide.
